
ACBF goes beyond providing solutions; we foster a culture of knowledge sharing and application. This empowers African institutions to become architects of their own development.

ACBF champions knowledge production and dissemination as a pillar for empowered stakeholders and sustainable development in Africa through knowledge exchange and evidence-based policymaking.




Over 500 knowledge products have been generated, including research studies and publications covering nearly 200 development topics.

Our virtual library is a user-friendly platform that serves as a vital resource hub, offering comprehensive search functionalities. It grants free access to a wealth of publications, research findings, and best practices, including ACBF's flagship reports and contributions from its extensive partner network.

In 2023 alone, over 200,463 visitors from more than 120 countries downloaded a cumulative 321GB of ACBF publications, highlighting the e-library's role as a true force for knowledge democratization in capacity development.

By empowering policymakers and stakeholders with readily accessible resources, ACBF fosters evidence-based policies and innovation and strengthens institutional capacities across Member States. This, in turn, fuels Africa's journey towards a prosperous, resilient, and inclusive future.
